Round 3: [CASE STUDY]

Jack runs an online speech and debate tournament software company. Hundreds of high schools and colleges around the country use his website to run and tabulate tournaments. As part of the user agreement, schools agree to the sharing of tournament data with “invested third parties”. This allows Jack to automatically send tournament results to national organizations to determine qualification standards.

Plumley University is one of the top schools in the country in speech and debate. However, their team for next year is still missing competitors in key events. The coach at Plumley asks Jack for data about high school students who do particularly well in these key events. The coach is willing to pay Jack a significant amount of money for every name Jack sends, plus a bonus if those students attend Plumley University.

While most of the data Plumley University is looking for is already on the website, Jack is hesitant. This was not the purpose of his company. He would need to analyze data not found on the website, like number of years in competition and competitiveness of specific regions. This would provide money to invest in website upgrades and development to improve his service and cut costs for everyone. However, Jack is worried people will stop using the site if this becomes public.

In this case, the Government team must defend the statement: **It is morally acceptable for Jack to send the student names.**
