Application for Admission to the *Studio Art* Major

Entry into the Studio Art Major

During the freshman and sophomore years, each student is expected to make significant progress in completing the freshman studio core and the sophomore studio requirements.

In order to gain admission to, and graduate with, the studio art major, students must maintain a 3.0 GPA in all studio courses and a 2.0 GPA in all art history and criticism courses.

How to apply for acceptance into the Studio Art major:

1. Complete this application form.
2. Print and attach an unofficial transcript listing all college courses taken to date (unofficial transcripts may be obtained from the Registrar's office or downloaded from CampusWeb). *Highlight all courses related to your intended major.*
3. Prepare a 10-minute electronic portfolio presentation of your work (Powerpoint, Keynote, PDF, or equivalent). Include your best work to date and be prepared to answer questions about it.
4. Your electronic portfolio and other application materials are to be presented to the combined Studio Art, Media Arts, and Graphic Design Faculties during the annual Major Application Night, typically held in the spring semester of your sophomore year (exact dates TBA).
